SANGUINARIA CANADENSIS

1. Young people; women at climaxis.
2. No marked mentals except hopeful state in phthysical patients.
3. Various headaches; periodic, esp. every seventh day; begin in occiput, spread upwards and settle over right eye; often end in vomiting; < at M.P. and **at climaxis**; sick headaches begin morning, increase during day and last till evening; > lying quiet in dark room; > sleep.
4. Naso-pharyngeal and ear complaints esp. with polypoid conditions.
5. Burning in various localities; hot palms and soles (Sulph.) climacteric flushes.
6. Pains in places where bones least covered, e.g. tibiæ, dorsi of hands, etc.
7. Lung complaints, even acute T.B. with hectic fever; **circumscribed redness of one or both cheeks**, sputa offensive even to patient.
8. Rheumatic pains in right arm and shoulder, < night in bed; cannot raise the arm.
9. Right-sided complaints.
10. **Modalities**; > lying quiet, in dark room.

SECALE CORNUTUM

1. Tall, thin, scrawny, feeble women of lax muscular fibre; old, decrepit subjects.
2. Extreme debility with restlessness, great anxiety and fear of death.
3. Collapse in choleroïd and other diseases, hippocratic face with contortion esp. about the mouth; **skin cold to touch yet external warmth**, covering, etc., **intolerable**.
4. Passive hæmorrhages; blood copious, dark, thick, watery, offensive; flow < motion.
5. Tendency to putrescence of all discharges.
6. Gangrenous conditions; of eruptions, etc.; dry, senile gangrene < external heat; small, painful boils with green contents.
7. Numbness and formication with or without paralysis; spastic paralysis.
8. Burning as of sparks falling on the parts.
9. Disorders of pregnancy and puerperium; labour pains prolonged, ineffectual or entirely wanting; **everything seems loose and open** but no expulsive power; (200th).
10. Patient chilly yet < external warmth; **markedly < covering up**.
