Therapeutics of Hair Loss

- Acid fluor:* Itching of the head and falling of the hair after fevers; the new hair is dry and breaks off; must comb the hair often. It mats so at the end.
- Aloes:* The hair come out in lumps, leaving bare patches; eyelashes also fall out; dry hair;
- Alumina:* Hair fall from all over body including lashes. Denuded appearance of scalp. Itching and numbness of scalp. Dandruff.
- Ammonium mur:* Large accumulation of branlike scales, with falling off of the hair, which has a deadened and lustreless of appearance, with great itching of the scalp.
- Anantherum:* Falling of hair from beard and eyebrows.
- Antimonium crud:* Losing hair from nervous headaches. Itching of the head.
- Arsenicum:* Touching the hair is painful; bald patches at or near the forehead, bregma, sides, scalp covered with dry scabs and scales, looking rough and dirty extending sometimes even to forehead, face and ears. Brittle and stiff hair. Dandruff.
- Aurum:* Syphilitic alopecia.
- Baryta carb:* Hairfall from vertex and moustache. Baldness, especially of the crown, in young people; scalp very sensitive to touch < from scratching, touch.
- Belladonna:* Hair fall from eyebrows and bregma brittle hair.
- Borax:* Hair rough & horny. Tangles at tips, sticks
